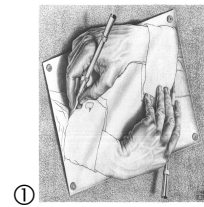
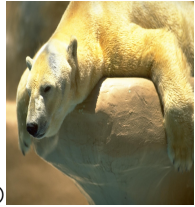

a drawer



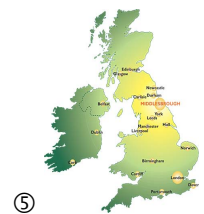
② a photograph

a cartoonist



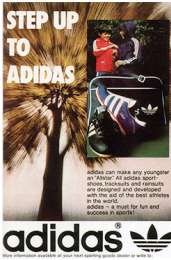
